




Taming the Tiger

Around 50 doctors all over India attended the webinar with good interaction.







World Glaucoma Week 2021













World Glaucoma week was held between march 7th to 13th, 2021, with sensitization to public and patients about the glaucoma disease - the silent killer of vision, by giving lectures by Glaucoma consultants, and display of posters in the premises of MGMEI. Patients were screened for glaucoma and neccessary investigations were done in selected patients. A webinar was conducted in collaboration with Indian Medical Association members, citing the importance of early detection and referral of patient to reduce the magnitude of prevalence of the disease leading to irreversible vision loss due to damage to the optic nerve.

Free door to door screening was done in villages to reach the unreached by following strict COVID 19 protocols, and the patients with eye diseases mostly cataracts and were referred to MGMEI for treatment where surgery was done as per indication free of cost





Free Eye Screening was done during the National Road safety Week 16th-23th Feb, 2021, with comprehensive eye check up including - vision testing, color vision, contrast sensitivity. The importance of a healthy eye was emphasized to the people.





The patients who visit the Vision centre are given primary eye care along with consultation with Doctors at MGMEI by tele ophthalmology if any complex eye condition is seen and medical treatment is given and if needed referred to MGMEI for further investigation and treatment at the earliest. Spectacles are dispensed in the vision centre to patients with refractive error. The surgery of the eye for the poor patients are done free of cost.
