


79th AIOC Virtual 2021




MGMEI in 79th AIOC Virtual 2021









Vision is Life

A prematurely born baby at 32 weeks and birth weight of 1100 gms was screened at a pediatric hospital and diagnosed as Zone I APROP in both the eyes, a severe and rapidly progressive blinding disease of infants. Parents were counseled regarding the need for immediate treatment and baby was given Intravitreal Injection Ranibizumab in both the eyes. One-month post injection, the disease has now regressed completely to immature retina and the baby has been kept on regular followups to look for any recurrences. With timely screening and prompt treatment we were able to salvage the child's vision.
