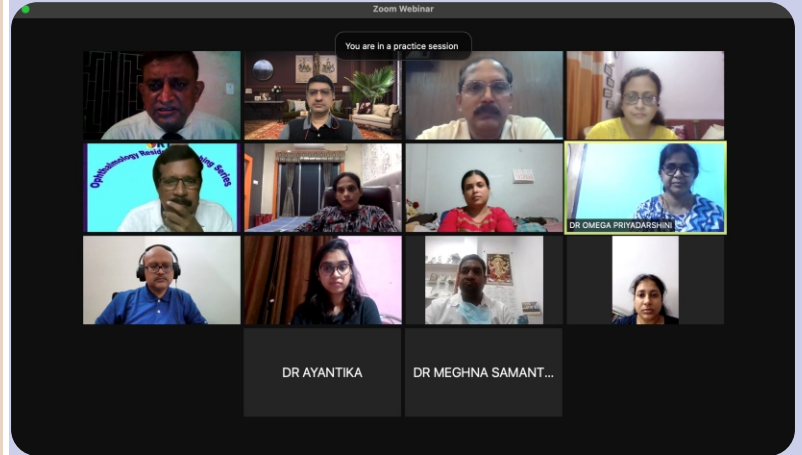
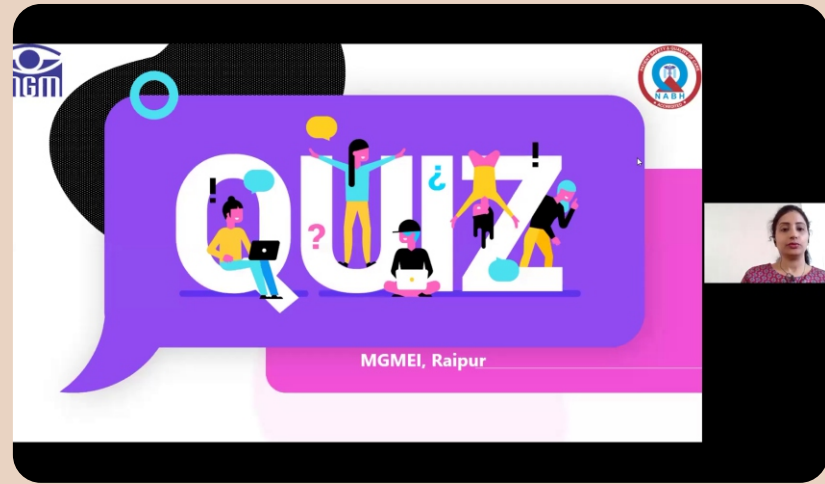
PHACO SHALA Virtual 2021



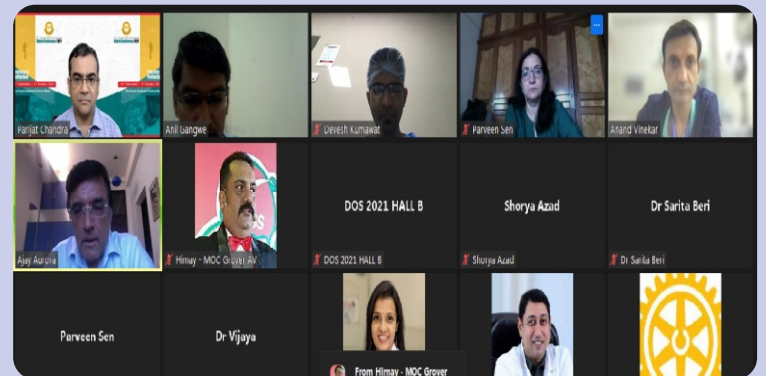

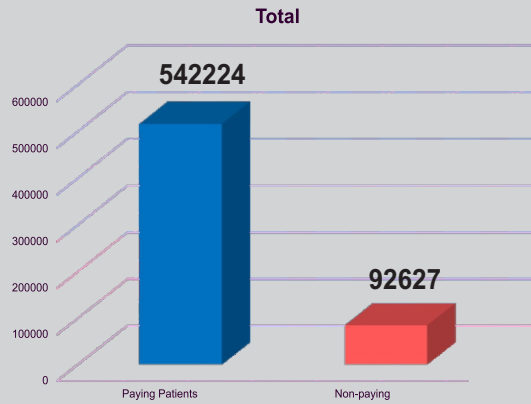

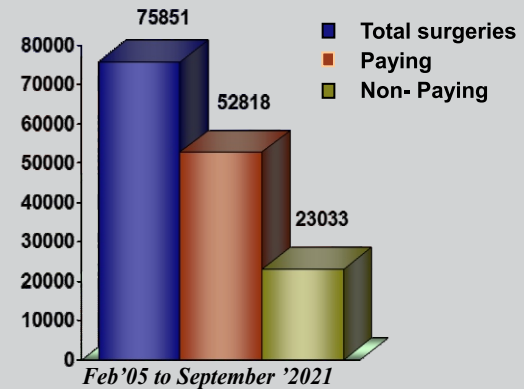


Total OPD Patients Nov 2004 to Sep 2021

Total Patients : 75,851



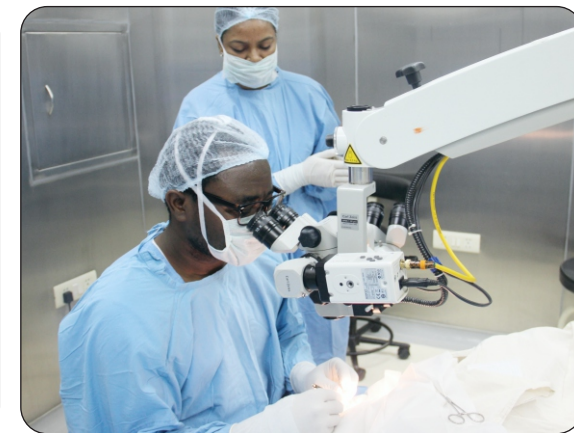
