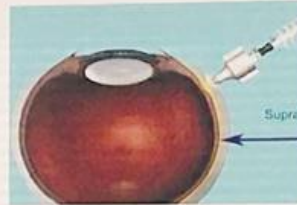

With a little help from Low vision devices.....

It is often presumed, the illiterate does not need low vision aids. A 28 year old female came to us with complaint of decreased vision since birth, because of which she was never sent to school. She had nystagmus with microcornea and uveal coloboma involving the macula. She had been operated for cataract, but her vision did not improve much. Though she was able to move about independently with her best corrected vision of 20/300, she had problems with mobility in direct sunlight and night, difficulty to see small objects. Since she was single, she wanted to be self dependent. With the help of few near vision aids(6D prismosphere) handsfree, she could thread a needle. We explained her about approach magnification, optimum illumination and how to use the device.

Today, with her determination, positive approach and some help in the right direction, she is self dependent and happy.
